### **Garden tractor pull**

A garden tractor pull will be the newest addition to this year's Fair events. This tractor pull has the same principles as a big truck tractor pull — they are just lawnmowers instead. This fun-fill event will be Tuesday evening, Aug. 19, 6 p.m. at the fairgrounds.

Rules:

1. Ornament must be made using any type of plant materials – dried or fresh
2. Ornament must not be larger than 8 inches in any direction
3. Exhibit may contain man-made items such as wire and accessories, but majority of elements (90%) must be from plant material
4. Accessories are permitted but must meet size restrictions
5. Ornament must have some type of hanger attached.

The winner will be awarded a special ribbon and a cash prize.

### **Scrapbook Challenge**

Put your creativity to work – create a scrapbook page.

Rules:

1. Page must be 12x12
2. All work must be done by person entering and their original work
3. Judging will be done on best use of tools, implements, neatness and uniqueness of page
4. Choose topic of choice from the following –
  - a. Travel
  - b. Sports

- d. Animal
- e. Misc.

The winner will be awarded a special ribbon and a cash prize.

#### **Tater Hot-Rod – Make Your Own Vegetable Race Car**

Can you build the most unique vegetable hot-rod in the county? We're looking for the best creative idea using vegetables to build a hot-rod.

Rules:

1. All cars must hold a vegetable of your choosing (such as a cucumber, squash, potato, etc.)
2. Cars can be no longer than 7 inches
3. Car width, including wheels, can be no wider than 5 inches
4. Age of contestant at time of fair, determines the category of competition
5. Car may be assembled using any materials
6. NO MOTORIZED parts may be attached to the car
7. All entries must be at the fair grounds on August 17<sup>th</sup> between 4:00 and 8:00 PM

The winner will receive a special ribbon and a cash prize.
